Additional \$2,500 USD given to one WAA recipient who has made a difference through impactful community service.	<p>Opens January 1</p> <p>Applications due March 31 and typically awarded by end of June.</p>	
Industry Training Program	Industry professionals working in the global moving industry interested in qualified industry training.	\$500 USD per person annually for pre-approved training programs through IAM Learning, FIDI, LACMA, EuRA, and WERC.	Offered on a rolling basis until all funding is distributed.	
Skill-Based Learning Award	Industry professionals in the global moving industry pursuing trade or vocational education, skill-based training, or certification programs.	<p>Courses that upskill the workforce in the global moving industry are all eligible.</p> <p>Up to 50% of the course cost with a maximum award of \$2,000 USD.</p>	Offered on a rolling basis until all funding is distributed.
